INAMP, in partnership with UNDP Moldova, organized a professional development course on the management of EU funds between November 27 and December 3.

The course was intended for representatives of the State Chancellery, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Infrastructure and Regional Development, Regional Development Agencies, local public administration of level I and II, as well as intercommunity development associations.

Alina Jijie, authorized trainer, and Dumitru-Tudor Jijie, doctor and university lecturer, facilitated sessions focused on:

- ? EU development assistance, such as the multiannual financial framework and funding mechanisms;
- ? Steps for good uptake of EU funds, such as idea generation, strategic framing and support structures;
- ? The partnership agreement with the European Commission, such as the format, role and involvement of beneficiaries;
- ? Program monitoring and reporting, such as the perspective of the authorities involved and procedures for detecting irregularities;
- ? The future of European funding, such as trends in cohesion policy and adaptation to political-economic developments.

?? INAMP will prioritize the strengthening of professional knowledge and skills, as well as the increase of institutional capacity, in order to prepare the public administration for the responsible management and efficient absorption of Union funds European.
