

# INAMP and the State Chancellery align the strategic priorities for the development of public administration in 2026



Today, January 21, 2026, a strategic planning meeting took place between the team of the National Institute of Administration and Public Management and the State Chancellery, devoted to the alignment of institutional priorities in the field of public administration.

The State Chancellery was represented by Alexandru Iacob, Deputy General Secretary of the Government, and Iulia Vacarenco, Head of the Professional Development Service of Civil Servants, and INAMP by Veronica Butnaru, Director, Vitalie Iovița, Deputy Director, and Valeriu Țurcanu, Head of the International Cooperation, Project Management and Communication Service.

The discussions focused on the main directions of activity and institutional consolidation, with an emphasis on the future implementation of the Plan for the training and professional development of public authorities personnel for the year 2026, as well as on the active involvement of INAMP in the key reform processes in the field of public administration.

INAMP reaffirms its role as a strategic partner of the State Chancellery in implementing the state policy regarding the professional development of public administration personnel. The agreed activity directions for the year 2026 reflect the common commitment to the professionalization of the public function and the acceleration of the modernization of the public administration in the Republic of Moldova.
