

INAMP strengthens cooperation with Germany for the modernization of public administration



The National Institute of Public Administration and Management (INAMP) hosted, on July 14, 2026, the first official visit of His Excellency Hubert Knirsch, the Ambassador of the Federal Republic of Germany to the Republic of Moldova.

Held at the initiative of the Ambassador, the high-level meeting constituted a strategic dialogue regarding the utilization of German expertise for the development of a modern, professional and citizen-oriented public administration.

The discussions were attended by Veronica Butnaru, Director of INAMP, and Valeriu Țurcanu, Head of International Cooperation, Project Management and Communication Service of INAMP.

The institutional dialogue focused on the following priority training directions:

- Management of public infrastructure projects at the local level;
- Modernizing and increasing the quality of local public services;
- Strengthening the capacities necessary for the European integration process.

The discussions highlighted the contribution of the Federal Republic of Germany and its cooperation organizations, including the German International Cooperation Agency (GIZ) and the German Foundation for International Legal Cooperation (IRZ).

INAMP thus reaffirms its commitment to transform international partnerships into sustainable institutional capacities, high-performing public services and resilient local administrations.
